

Chapter 412 – Parking and Standing

Section 412.1 – Intent

An Ordinance to provide for the regulation of parking and standing of commercial vehicles, on both sides of 29 Mile Road east of Gratiot Road, and to provide penalties for the violation thereof.

Section 412.2 – Title

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Lenox Township Parking and Standing Ordinance.

Section 412.3 – Definitions

The words, “parking” and “standing,” wherever used in this Ordinance, is defined to mean allowing a commercial vehicle to remain standing for more than five (5) minutes, regardless of whether that vehicle is occupied by a driver at the time, and regardless of whether that vehicle engine is running.

Section 412.4 – Regulations

No commercial vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, trucks and/or any vehicle used to haul garbage or debris, shall engage in parking or standing on either side of 29 Mile Road, east of Gratiot Road only, for more than five (5) minutes.

Section 412.5 – Violation, Penalties

Any person, firm, or corporation who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with or resist the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both, such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court for each offense.
