

Chapter 414 – Uniform Traffic Code

Section 414.1 - Intent

An Ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships, and villages.

Section 414.2 – Code and Existing Township Ordinances Adopted

The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships, and villages promulgated by the Director of the State Police, and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, and amendments as an amendments as published in the Quarterly Supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code including amendments to the Uniform Traffic Code which were promulgated by the Director of the Department of State Police, effective January 27, 1981, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as well as Lenox Township Ordinance No. 406, Driving while License Suspended (DWLS) and Lenox Township Ordinance No. 411, Operating Under the Influence of Liquor (OUIL) previously adopted by the Lenox Township Board of Trustees.

Section 414.3 – Reference in Code

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan cities, townships, and villages to “government unit” shall mean the Township of Lenox.
