

The Lenox Township Fire Department is accepting applications for the position of paid-on-call firefighters.

Candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Live in Lenox Township or within 1 mile of a Lenox Township border or not more than 10 minutes from a Lenox Fire station
- Possess a High School Diploma or GED
- Have a good driving and pass a criminal background check
- Pass a pre-employment physical including a drug and alcohol screen

Once employed the following training will be paid for or provided by the Lenox Fire Dept:

Phase 1: Dispatch and department orientation training, time frame 2-3 months.

Phase 2: Completion State of Michigan Medical First response training and licensing, time frame 3 to 4 months.

Phase 3: Following successful Dispatch and First Responder training, and with a 3-year commitment to remain an active member of the Lenox Fire Dept. Michigan Firefighter Training Council Fire Fighter I & II Training as well as Hazardous Materials Operations, 5 to 9 months.

- Note: Most training is available nights and weekends

Persons licensed as EMTs or Paramedics:

May be given credit for training phases 1 or 2 above.

If firefighting certification is required, EMT candidates may be eligible for up to 100% pre-payment of their firefighter I & II certification, while Paramedics may be eligible to have 50% of their training paid by LTFD. Paid training is subject to a written agreement with the Lenox Fire Dept to remain an active member for a minimum of 3 years.

Wages:

Hourly wages are paid per run and for other fire department related business and is commensurate, with training, seniority and years of service.
