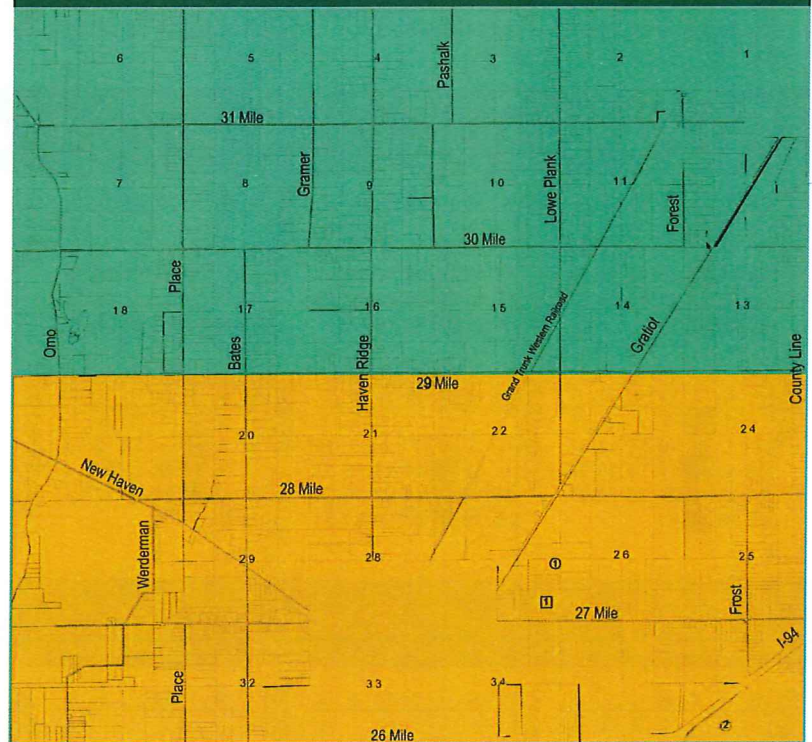

LENOX Regular Household Waste

- WM provided 96 gallon toter
- 32 – 35 gallon containers made of plastic, metal or fiberglass
- Maximum 50 lbs. as regulated by OSHA

BULK ITEMS

- One (1) Bulk large item / white good per year (anything that canNOT go in a regular residential truck curbside.
- Advance notification is required (866-797-9018) for additional bulk disposal for a fee to be charged to the homeowner.

LENOX Yard Waste (Defined as leaves, grass clippings and garden debris, shrubbery (no root ball), brush and tree trimmings meeting dimensions specified below)

- Tree branches - bundles not to exceed 4 feet and less than 2" in diameter
- Kraft bags or 32-35 gallon container marked clearly with YARDWASTE sticker
- 15 bag/container limit
- WM provides township with YARDWASTE stickers

LENOX Recyclables

- 18 gallon bin or container up to 64 gallon size clearly marked "RECYCLING"
- Maximum 50 lbs. as regulated by OSHA
- RECYCLING Stickers provided by WM to Lenox Township
- **ABSOLUTELY NO PLASTIC BAGS** - neither clear nor opaque -plastic bags are a contaminant at the Material Recovery Facility and cause equipment damage and lost productivity, adding to the cost to recycle <https://vimeo.com/170817933?lite=1>

 - CARDBOARD - broken down and flattened, no staples or plastic bands, NO pizza boxes soiled with food
 - GLASS - clear and colored - **empty** (no liquids)
 - PLASTIC CONTAINERS - **empty** - (no liquids)
ONLY #'s 1, 2, 4, 5 & 7 - **NO 3 or 6** accepted at this time
 - Metals (aluminum and steel cans) - **empty** (no liquids) labels are o.k.
 - Cartons – **empty**

FREE DISPOSAL CARD guidelines for Pine Tree Acres

1. Driver's License, and picture ID must be presented at WM prior to disposal.
2. All residents must drive over the scales and comply with all of WM's Rules and Regulations while on site (to assure compliance with site requirements).
3. NO HAZARDOUS WASTE
4. NO PROHIBITED WASTE (liquids, whole tires, etc.)
5. NO COMMERCIAL DISPOSAL
6. *No stumps, building demolition material (NO RESIDENTIAL DEMO), stoves, refrigerators, tires or other comparable bulky materials, except by payment of normal rates.*
7. All loads & material coming on site of landfill must be covered.
